

Milton Society Privacy Statement 2022

Milton Society (MS) takes privacy very seriously and complies with the requirements of the PECR 2003 and GDPR 2018.

Personal data is only processed and messages sent for the purposes of conducting our not-for-profit constituted purposes for public good. This includes the management of membership, possible future membership, relevant news, events and fund raising.

New registrants on our website CONSENT to their contact details being held and messages sent by MS.

MS has applied the GDPR 'soft opt-in' to existing current paid members and will always offer an 'opt-out' with any email contact. MS has applied an 'opt-in' consent request to all existing registrants who have expressed an interest in regeneration but have not joined as a member.

MS is both 'controller' and 'processor' of the data it collects and stores and any data query should be sent to us at the contact details elsewhere on this website.

MS will uphold the following data protection principles:

- a) processing will be fair, lawful and transparent
- b) data be collected for specific, explicit, and legitimate purposes
- c) data collected will be adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary for the purposes of processing
- d) data will be kept accurate and up to date. Data which is found to be inaccurate will be rectified or erased without delay
- e) data is not kept for longer than is necessary for its given purpose
- f) data will be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of personal data including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction or damage by using appropriate technical or organisation measures

Your information is secure and is not passed to any other party for marketing or any other commercial purpose. MS retains all data on password protected data bases only accessible to officers of MS.
